MEDITATE

1. Read Joshua 22:10-24:33. Record observations below.

DWELL

2. As you read through Joshua 22:10-34, take note and mark the following repeating words: *altar, witness, unfaithful act, turn away from following the Lord, and tabernacle.*

Summarize what is happening in this passage of Scripture in a few sentences below:

3. What was finally given to the people in Joshua 23:1? Why is that significant? (hint: look back at Joshua 1:13, 15).
4. After God had given His people rest, what was the challenge that Joshua gave the people in the rest of Joshua 23-24?

GOSPEL CONNECTION:

5. These chapters are teaching how the people of God are to live in relation to God and one another. Read Hebrews 10:19-25. What does this passage teach us about how we today are to live in relation to God and one another?

6. Consider ways you too will need to examine whom you serve. Are there "foreign gods" you need to put away? In what ways can worship of the One True God help you demolish and destroy false gods you turn to for satisfaction? Worth?

REFLECT

7. As you consider all of Joshua, can you write out 3-5 major themes/lessons you learned throughout the book?.

8. If you had to summarize the book of Joshua in one word or short phrase what would it be?.

9. What most significantly challenged you during your time in Joshua?

10. What most encouraged you as you studied Joshua?

PRAY

11. Consider taking one of the answers above (what was challenging or encouraging) and praying through those to close our time in Joshua. May you find rest in the God who is faithful to fulfill His promises and redeem His people.
